

SIMMONS 3 – SCHOOL PROGRAM AGREEMENT

This Agreement outlines the responsibilities and expectations for hosting the Beyond the Classroom program.

PARTIES AND PURPOSE

This Agreement is entered into by and between Simmons 3, a Louisiana nonprofit organization (“Simmons 3”), and [School Name] (“School”).

Simmons 3 provides an in-person educational program titled “Beyond the Classroom.”

This Agreement outlines the responsibilities and expectations for hosting the program at the School.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW AND CONTENT DISCLOSURE

The “Beyond the Classroom” program is an in-person educational presentation centered on decision-making, personal responsibility, character, and the long-term impact and legacy of individual choices, including those related to impaired driving.

The program incorporates real-life experiences, discussion, and visual materials and images that address impaired driving incidents, loss, and grief. These materials may include non-graphic depictions of vehicle crashes and funeral-related content and may be emotionally impactful for some students.

The School acknowledges that it has reviewed the nature of the program, confirms the content is appropriate for its students, and accepts responsibility for determining student participation, including consideration of any students who may be more sensitive to the subject matter.

SCHOOL RESPONSIBILITIES

The School retains full responsibility for student supervision, behavior, and participation during the program.

The School agrees to ensure that appropriate staff members are present at all times during the program and remain responsible for maintaining order and addressing any student needs.

The School is responsible for determining which students are appropriate to attend the program based on its knowledge of its student population, including consideration of students who may have experienced trauma, loss, or other circumstances that could make the content more sensitive or triggering.

The School is responsible for all parent or guardian communication related to the program, including any opt-out procedures.

The School is responsible for providing or arranging any necessary student support, including counseling or follow-up services, if needed.

MEDIA AND PUBLICITY

Simmons 3 may take photographs and video recordings during the program for use in promotional, educational, and awareness materials, including social media, website content, and marketing.

The School is responsible for obtaining any necessary parent or guardian permissions related to student media participation in accordance with its policies.

The School grants Simmons 3 permission to use the name of the School and approved images or recordings from the program for promotional and awareness purposes and will notify Simmons 3 of any students who should not be photographed or recorded.

LIABILITY

To the fullest extent permitted under applicable law, the School retains responsibility for student supervision, behavior, and the condition of the premises during the program.

Simmons 3 provides the program for educational and awareness purposes only and does not provide medical, mental health, or counseling services.

The School assumes responsibility for addressing any student needs, including emotional or behavioral responses to the program.

Simmons 3 shall not be responsible for any injuries, damages, or claims arising from the School's supervision of students or the condition of the School's facilities.

Nothing in this Agreement limits liability for gross negligence or intentional misconduct.

CANCELLATION AND SCHEDULING

The School agrees to provide reasonable notice if the program needs to be rescheduled or canceled.

Simmons 3 reserves the right to reschedule or cancel the program due to weather conditions, safety concerns, travel limitations, or other circumstances beyond its control.

In the event of severe weather or unsafe conditions, including but not limited to flooding, heavy rain, or hazardous travel conditions, both parties will work in good faith to reschedule the program.

Simmons 3 will make reasonable efforts to accommodate scheduling changes based on availability.

GENERAL TERMS

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State in which the program is conducted.

This Agreement represents the full understanding between the parties and may only be modified in writing.
